

### <u>Cross Disciplinary Competency</u> <u>Indicators</u> - Examples

- Coordination and Collaboration Uses effective communication skills with others.
- Family Centered Practice Collaborates with the family to identify the family's strengths, needs, concerns, and priorities.
- Intervention/Instruction as Informed by Evidence – Identifies and includes evidence-based practices on the intervention plan (IEP/IFSP).
- Professionalism Demonstrates ethical decision making and professional behavior.





#### **Program and Course**

- MSLP 654: Early Intervention
- 23 enrolled students
- Hybrid format
  - 75% face to face

#### **Case Study Assignment**

- Purpose: Select and analyze a case study, apply knowledge and skills, improve professional writing, & facilitate a group presentation
- Group Paper and Presentation
- Assessment Rubric
  - General Requirements (e.g., in-text citations, reference list, APA)
  - Topical Information (e.g., depth of knowledge, evidence and rationale)
  - Presentation (e.g., flow and pace, ability to answer questions)



### **Assignment Description**

- Work with assigned group members.
- Discuss the case study, conduct research, and draft
  *collaborative* responses to the questions posed.
- Base responses on readings, lectures, outside research, videos, websites, and group discussions.
- Support responses with evidence/research.
- Develop a PowerPoint presentation focused on what you learned about the 4 competency areas.
- Present what you learned.

- Course: OTD 123
  - Pediatrics and Occupational Therapy



#### **Activity with All Students Together**

- Implementation:
  - Zoom Small groups of ECE and OTD students
  - Took on roles from IFSP/IEP team
  - Discussed as if in real IFSP/IEP meeting
  - Documented ideas and discussion
  - Whole group sharing



### **Student Feedback**

- Benefits:
  - 87% At least somewhat beneficial to team with another discipline
  - Beneficial to learn role in IFSP/IEP meetings
  - Helpful for faculty to share ideas/expertise
- Adjustments for Next Time:
  - Allow students to get to know each other
  - Provide clear expectations and background
  - Match students number and education level
